

## **Y7 Catch up premium 2018-2019**

The school is due to receive an additional £2, 273 for pupils in year 7 who did not achieve at least level 4 in reading and/or maths at the end of KS2 to be used in the academic year 2018-2019 (see <https://www.gov.uk/guidance/year-7-literacy-and-numeracy-catch-up-premium-guide-for-schools> for how funding is allocated to schools)

The school has assessed the needs of the students in Y7 at the start of the academic year and looked at the ways to support the learning and development of English and Maths skills with these students. In this academic year there are 5 students in Y7, 2 have CLDD, 1 has SLD and 2 have SLDC needs.

For the 2018-2019 academic year the premium money will be used to

- Support key skills groups with a focus on communication development in the spring and summer terms
- Purchase additional resources for students to support their work in English and Maths
- Provide focused 1:1 sessions for those students with CLDD

In terms of impact on progress – the following information needs to be taken in to account:

Of the 5 students

- 1 is working on an alternative individual assessment –and progress is being assessed through a MAPP framework document.
- 1 has a regressive condition and therefore target setting and progress are individualised to their very specific needs.
